Three \$1,000 Scholarships

The Access Scholarship is awarded to three Iowa high school seniors whose high schools, and chosen colleges, are members of Iowa ACAC.

- A high school counselor, teacher, administrator or school board member must nominate students who would benefit from this scholarship.
- Candidates must exhibit a commitment to learning and have demonstrated involvement and leadership in their schools, the community and/or service to others.
- In an effort to increase access to under-represented populations, special consideration will be given to those who are from under-represented populations, first generation, or demonstrate financial need.
